

Role description: Jo's Voices

Jo's Voices use their experience to review Jo's Cervical Cancer Trust's information, support services and other activities.

They help us make everything we do more personal and relevant, so we can support everyone affected in the right way.

Who are our Jo's Voices?

- Affected by cervical cancer or cell changes (abnormalities), including carers, partners, family or friends.
- Experience of cervical screening (a smear test), HPV or the vaccine.
- Have a desire to help us improve our information and other services.
- Live in the UK.
- Age 18+.

We limit Jo's Voices to 100 people, so we can offer the best possible experience.

We usually refresh our Jo's Voices every 5 years, while supporting past members to stay engaged with Jo's Cervical Cancer Trust in another way.

What do Jo's Voices do?

- Provide detailed feedback on the content and design of printed and online information materials.
- Offer insight into other Jo's Cervical Cancer Trust activities, including campaigns and support services.
- Jo's Voices is sometimes used as a recruitment pool for research opportunities with external organisations.

How we support you

- Offer resources to support you in your volunteer role.
- Give you at least 1 week to review.
- Provide quarterly feedback about the reviews we receive.
- Once a year, you have the chance to complete a survey to reflect on your role and let us know how we can improve our volunteer offering.
- Provide a reference.
